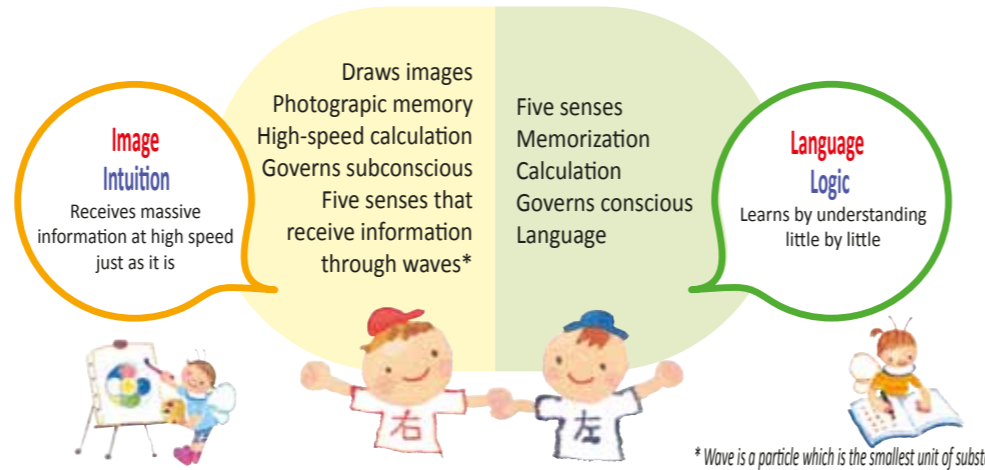


The Shichida Method cultivates children's hearts and fosters the growth of both the right and the left brains with the proper balance!

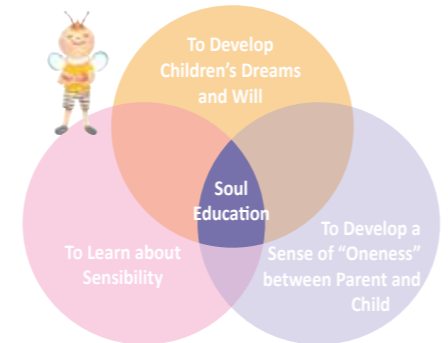

Highlights of Our Program

6 - 12 MONTHS

Babies are already able to receive massive amounts of input from their environment. Proper stimuli from flash cards, songs and games will help to activate their right brain with the best results. More importantly, all activities involve parents to enhance parent-child bonding, leading to the baby to become more responsive to their parents' actions.



1 - 2 YEARS OLD

Children start developing their photographic memory and can reproduce what they have only glanced at. Activities like Eidetic Imaging not only help to develop this ability, but are also fun and rewarding games. They love playing such games and will grow to enjoy the learning experience.



2 - 3 YEARS OLD

Children have the ability to memorize around 20 pictures through storytelling using the Linking Method. As their ability to express themselves through speech grows, they are encouraged to describe their feelings and draw what they have imaged into pictures. This achievement brings them satisfaction and builds confidence as self-awareness grows.



3 - 4 YEARS OLD

Children will begin using more of their left brain. More logical activities, such as critical thinking, numbers and language, will be added in addition to the right brain activities to "pole-bridge" both brains. During this rapid-growth stage of language acquisition, emphasis will be put on reciting, reading and writing.



4 - 5 YEARS OLD

Children continue to develop their memory using the Peg Method. They will be able to express themselves through drawing pictures. Their creativity keeps growing as they understand the storybooks they read. They start to have their own thoughts and are mature enough to show discipline.

5 - 6 YEARS OLD

Children will be able to write creatively. Through the Dot Method, they will be able to perform calculations in a high-speed manner. They will not only be aware of themselves, but classmates around them. They enjoy making friends and learning the importance of sensibility.

PROFESSOR MAKOTO SHICHIDA

His Life and Achievements

Professor Makoto Shichida was a highly respected figure in Japan for his contribution to early childhood education. He started his lifelong journey in child education in 1958 teaching children English. The success in his early work with children motivated him to dedicate more than 40 years of his life to early childhood education and developing techniques to stimulate the development and use of the whole brain. Professor Shichida held a Doctorate in Education, authored over two hundred books and received numerous accolades for his work on child education. The Shichida Method has been developing children for more than 30 years.
